Historical Data:

Built in 1788 by Lt. Thomas Hayden for East Windsor Hill's leading merchant Mr. John Watson, The Watson House was among the first in the district of its kind and the only remaining mansion still standing in the Connecticut River Valley. It's spacious six thousand eight hundred square feet of living space on three floors, offers a unique setting from the past.

The refurbished Palladian mansion was renovated into a Bed and Breakfast in the 1990's, and is now owned and run by Brandy and Michael Feldmeier. The building holds a rich historical past and is rumored to be a junction point of the Underground Railroad but to date we haven't verified this claim through our research.

Another interesting reminder of the past is a grave of Mary Ann Hayden on the property born May 23, 1816 and died August 15, 1818. Although the surname for Mary Ann is Hayden, strangely there's no supportive historical evidence of her being a relative to Lt. Hayden or why this young girl was buried here in the first place.

Occupants Statement:

Brandy's daughter has claimed on many occasions to have played with a little girl by the name of Mary Ann and has apparently shown herself to one other house guest. Mary Ann is said to be a harmless spirit although becomes mischievous during rest time, waking Brandy's daughter up from a sound sleep looking for attention. Brandy has also assertively announced for the spirits to cease their noisy disturbance while her child was napping in the afternoon. Once this demand was voiced the commotion ended abruptly. One of Mary Ann's favorite toys is a battery powered talking book that continues to sound off in the middle of the night even after the batteries have been removed.

Investigations Notes:

This is a compilation of three separate investigations spanning from 2008 and 2009. Baseline readings were observed prior, during and at the end of each investigation. Ambient temperature variations were no more than 5 degrees Fahrenheit which deems insignificance in paranormal methodology. Standard EMF sweeps showed variations from 0.1 Mg to 0.4 Mg using a Tri-field Natural set to magnetic which typically are normal fluctuations.

Investigation:

11/20/08

During an audio interactive response communication session at 9:10 pm voice phenomena was heard real-time. After reviewing the audio anomaly, we believe it to be of Native American origins and are still waiting for confirmation from a linguist from the South Windsor Historical Society. It would be inappropriate to assume the voice to be an intelligent response to the prior question until more information is acquired.

No video or digital still evidence was captured during this investigation.

01/24/09

One particular IRC audio session from 11:59 pm to 12:14am was extremely active. One Class "A" EVP, one Class "B" and several Class "C's" were heard only after playback. Monitoring throughout all audio sessions were performed usually by two participants to rule out voice phenomena and audio contamination by investigators and other naturally occurring ambient noise.

At approximately 10:24 p.m. in the Adams Suite a soft capture of what we believe to be a child melodically humming was heard after playback on a digital audio recorder.

04/04/09

Careful review of all video footage from camcorders and our DVR system revealed no paranormal evidence but one rather interesting segment from the DVR at 1:36 am of a pulsating orb was captured. We strongly believe it has no paranormal foundation but nonetheless to date we haven't encountered this particular phenomena on any previous video footage. No audio or digital still evidence was found on this investigation.

This location is been ongoing throughout the last several years and continues to present our team with challenges in many different areas.

We have encountered both residual and intelligent energies in E.V.P and voice phenomenal yet, have been unable to locate the true hot spots as they seemingly shift to a different location on every investigation.

The majority of audio captures are soft spoken in nature, on the verge of being a class "C".

With over a 200 year legacy, both male and female, young and old, we have had the honor of experiencing an array of spirits, each with their own story to tell or in some cases, to sing. We are very grateful to the Feldmeiers' for their genuine hospitality and their undying faith in our profession.



Home base for N.E.A.P.R.I. is located on the second floor of the Watson House, providing an optimum middle point for strategic equipment placement.

Although hot spots frequently change within the Watson House, the Adams Suite has provided us with evidence during our last few visits.



The final resting place for Mary Ann Hayden is located on the grounds of the Watson House. It is unknown why she is buried here, having no ancestral ties with the Watsons. Her gravestone reads:

*"In memory of
Mary Ann Hayden
Born May 23, 1816
Died August 15, 1816
Died at the age of 2 yrs old"*



This is Brandy's daughters' room where most of the mischievous activity between Mary Ann and Brandy's daughter occurs. Brandy's daughter has awoken on numerous occasions in the middle of the night singing an unfamiliar song which she can then repeat the following day.

This is also where the book can be found that Mary Ann likes to set off at all hours of the night. Brandy has also caught her daughter having a full conversation when there has been no one present in the room.
